Christmas Jumper Day

Dear Parent/Carer,

On Friday 13th December, our school will be taking part in Save the Children's Christmas Jumper Day. We know times are tough, so please remember that £1 is only a suggested donation - and if you can't donate, or you can spare less, that's fine too. Any amount – 5p, 10p, 20p, 50p - makes you an awesome fundraiser!

There's no need to buy a new jumper. You could upcycle an old jumper, get crafty or head to your local charity shop to buy a pre-loved festive knit. Alternatively, your child is invited to attend in non-uniform.

To help this day run smoothly, students are asked to be sensible and follow usual academy behaviour guidelines and obey a few simple extra rules:

- There should be no low-cut tops, exposed midriffs (stomach area) or short skirts/shorts
- There should be no pyjamas or any other sleeping wear being worn
- There should be no offensive logos or offensive writing/drawings on jumpers or other clothing
- Students will not be allowed to wear caps, but they may wear a Christmas hat around the academy if they wish (please note they may be asked to take this off in some lessons).
- Make up and nail extensions may be worn during this day, but we do ask that this is not excessive and that this doesn't stop students taking part in any of their scheduled lesson. They must also be removed in line with usual uniform policy by Monday 15th December.
- Please ensure that your child brings P.E/ Sport kit if they have it on their timetable that day and appropriate shoes for design or food technology.

Anyone not adhering to these rules or wearing inappropriate clothing will be dealt with in accordance with usual academy procedures.
